He holds a Master's of Science degree in Economics from University of Amsterdam and a Master's of Arts degree from University of Leiden.

Mr. Kuijpers (b.1966) graduated in 1992 from Leiden University in the Netherlands with a Master's of Arts degree in Japanese Language and Culture. Mr. Kuijpers' professional career started in 1993 at the Consulate-General of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Kobe/Osaka and in 1996 he became Vice-Consul for Cultural Affairs.
